Contest Rules

January 30th at The Break

TO ENTER, YOU MUST REGISTER ONLINE AT [KREWEOFBANANIMALS.COM/EVENTS](https://kreweofbananimals.com/events)

By submitting your online registration, you hereby agree:

- that you have read and agree to all contest rules in their entirety.
- that you understand that although significant prizes are awarded, this contest event is for fun.
- that you understand that the Krewe of Bananimals and the Break Bar will do their best to keep this contest as fair as possible, but neither can see and control all circumstances of the contest or judging.
- that you do agree to abide by the judges' decisions and will not seek any compensation or awards that they do not assign on the date of this contest.

Times:

- 11:30 -12:00 Chili delivered to The Break. Must be in a crock pot with your name on the side of the pot and delivered to Terri or Darryel by no later than 12:00 PM.
- 12:30 - 1:00 Judges will sample Chili and vote
- 1:00 or after Everyone is invited to eat the Chili as soon as judging has completed and votes counted
- 1:30'ish Winners will be announced and prizes awarded as quickly as possible

Contest Categories:

All Chili awards will be based on the judges' decisions. Chilies can be any **RED** Chili with or without beans, with or without meat.

Contest Rules

- Bring your Chili in a Warm or Hot Crock Pot. Make sure you have your name somewhere on the Crock Pot. Feel free to bring an extension cord if you wish your chili to remain plugged in.
- If you want to bring anything else other than Chili, it will be set out for everyone to eat and will in no way be associated with your Chili entry for judging purposes.
- If any participant identifies their Chili to a judge or encourages anyone to vote for their Chili, they will be removed from the competition. No exceptions!
- After 2:00 you may pick up your crock pot. You must remove your Crock Pot from The Break before close of business the day of the competition. (The Break nor The Krewe of Bananimals are responsible for Crock Pots, any of your dishes or items you bring or may leave behind).
- Your Hosts (Terri and Darryel) will be responsible for stirring all the Chilies from the time you drop off your chili up to the time for judging. At no time may you touch, stir or adjust your Chili during the judging. After judging has ended, you may stir or do whatever you want with your Chili.
- If you need any help or have any questions, contact Terri or Darryel.

Judging

- Judges will not be allowed to enter the room with the crock pots. Samples of each chili will be placed in a non-descript container and only identified by a random # that will be in no particular order of how the crock pots are set up. The chili samples will be personally brought out to the judges.
- All judges will each select a 1st, 2nd and 3rd place Chili.
- The 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners will be decided by a simple majority of votes. In the event of a tie, we will place both names in a box and a name will be drawn blindly for the position.
